- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 6, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 6.004 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 6.004. SCHOOL DISTRICTS EXEMPT FROM SECURITY FOR COURT
- 8 COSTS AND APPEAL BOND. A school district may institute and
- 9 prosecute suits without giving security for cost and may appeal
- 10 from judgment without giving supersedeas or cost bond.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 6.004, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 12 as added by this Act, applies only to a suit or appeal filed on or
- 13 after the effective date of this Act. A suit or appeal filed before
- 14 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 15 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 16 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
