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1	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration with the Texas Department of Insurance
3	of certain contract examiners.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 401.107, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) A person with whom another state contracts to perform
9	any examination initiated by the other state of an insurer
10	domiciled in this state shall register with and provide the
11	following information to the department's chief examiner:
12	<pre>(1) the person's name;</pre>
13	(2) if the person is not an individual, the identity of
14	each examiner or other person who will perform any part of the
15	examination;
16	(3) the name of the state that contracted with the
17	person;
18	(4) the identity of the insurer to be examined; [and]
19	(5) a description of each issue that the person has
20	been contracted to examine <u>;</u>
21	(6) an estimate of the examination costs to be charged
22	to the insurer to be examined;
23	(7) a copy of any contract between the person and the
24	state regulatory body that initiated the examination and a letter

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1	authorizing the examination; and
2	(8) a list of the previous examinations conducted on
3	the same insurer on behalf of any state within the last three years.
4	(a-1) On accepting a person's registration under Subsection
5	(a), the department shall send written confirmation of the
6	acceptance to:
7	(1) the person;
8	(2) the insurer to be examined; and
9	(3) the state regulatory body that initiated the
10	examination.
11	SECTION 2. Section 751.052, Insurance Code, is amended by
12	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
13	follows:
14	(b) A person with whom another state contracts to perform
15	any market analysis or examination initiated by the other state of
16	an insurer domiciled in this state shall register with and provide
17	the following information to the department's chief examiner:
18	<pre>(1) the person's name;</pre>
19	(2) if the person is not an individual, the identity of
20	each examiner or other person who will perform any part of the
21	market analysis or examination;
22	(3) the name of the state that contracted with the
23	person;
24	(4) the identity of the insurer to be examined; [and]
25	(5) a description of each issue that the person has
26	been contracted to examine <u>;</u>
27	(6) an estimate of the examination costs to be charged

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to the insurer to be examined; 1 2 (7) a copy of any contract between the person and the state regulatory body that initiated the examination and the letter 3 4 authorizing the examination; and 5 (8) a list of the previous examinations conducted on 6 the same insurer on behalf of any state within the last three years. 7 (b-1) On accepting a person's registration under Subsection (b), the department shall send written confirmation of the 8 9 acceptance to: 10 (1) the person; 11 (2) the insurer to be examined; and (3) the state regulatory body that initiated the 12 13 examination. SECTION 3. Section 4053.107, Insurance Code, is amended by 14 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as 15 follows: 16 (d) A person with whom another state contracts to perform 17 any examination initiated by the other state of a managing general 18 19 agent licensed under this chapter shall register with and provide the following information to the department's chief examiner: 20 (1) the person's name; 21 if the person is not an individual, the identity of 22 (2) each examiner or other person who will perform any part of the 23 examination; 24 (3) the name of the state that contracted with the 25 person; 26 the identity of the managing general agent to be 27 (4)

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1	examined; [and]
2	(5) a description of each issue that the person has
3	been contracted to examine;
4	(6) an estimate of the examination costs to be charged
5	to the managing general agent to be examined;
6	(7) a copy of any contract between the person and the
7	state regulatory body that initiated the examination and the letter
8	authorizing the examination; and
9	(8) a list of the previous examinations conducted on
10	the same managing general agent on behalf of any state within the
11	last three years.
12	(d-1) On accepting a person's registration under Subsection
13	(d), the department shall send written confirmation of the
14	acceptance to:
15	(1) the person;
16	(2) the managing general agent to be examined; and
17	(3) the state regulatory body that initiated the
18	examination.
19	SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
20	401.107, 751.052, and 4053.107, Insurance Code, apply only to an
21	examination commencing on or after September 1, 2011. An
22	examination commencing before September 1, 2011, is subject to the
23	law in effect on the date the examination was commenced, and that
24	law is continued in effect for that purpose.
25	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
26	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
27	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2011 ______
