- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 58.106, Family Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section,
- 8 information contained in the juvenile justice information system is
- 9 confidential information for the use of the department and may not
- 10 be disseminated by the department except:
- 11 (1) with the permission of the juvenile offender, to
- 12 military personnel of this state or the United States;
- 13 (2) to a person or entity to which the department may
- 14 grant access to adult criminal history records as provided by
- 15 Section 411.083, Government Code;
- 16 (3) to a juvenile justice agency;
- 17 (4) to the Texas Youth Commission and the Texas
- 18 Juvenile Probation Commission for analytical purposes; [and]
- 19 (5) to the office of independent ombudsman of the
- 20 Texas Youth Commission; and
- 21 (6) to a county, justice, or municipal court
- 22 exercising jurisdiction over a juvenile under Section 54.021.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
