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1 AN ACT 2 relating to the operation of the Kimble County, McCulloch County, Mason County, and Menard County Juvenile Boards. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 152.1401, Human Resources Code, is 6 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 7 (f) The Kimble County Juvenile Board and the juvenile boards of one or more counties that are adjacent to or in close proximity 8 to Kimble County may agree to operate together. Juvenile boards 9 10 operating together may appoint one fiscal officer to receive and disburse funds for the boards. 11 SECTION 2. Section 152.1601, Human Resources Code, 12 is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 13 14 (f) The McCulloch County Juvenile Board and the juvenile boards of one or more counties that are adjacent to or in close 15 16 proximity to McCulloch County may agree to operate together. Juvenile boards operating together may appoint one fiscal officer 17 to receive and disburse funds for the boards. 18 SECTION 3. Section 152.1661, Human Resources Code, 19 is amended by amending Subsections (b), (c), and (d) and adding 20 Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows: 21 The juvenile board shall elect one of its members as 22 (b) [court judge is the] chairman [of the board and its chief 23 24 administrative-officer].

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The commissioners court shall [may] pay the juvenile 1 (c) 2 board members an annual salary of not less than \$600, payable [set by the commissioners court at not more than \$1,200 as compensation 3 4 for the added duties imposed on the members. The salary shall be 5 paid] in equal monthly installments from the general fund or any other available fund of the county. The commissioners court may 6 7 increase the compensation at any time. Sections 152.0002, 152.0004, 152.0005(b) [152.0005], 8 (d) 9 and 152.0006[, 152.0007, and 152.0008] do not apply to the juvenile 10 board of Mason County. 11 (e) The juvenile board shall hold regular annual meetings on dates set by the board and special meetings at the call of the 12 chairman. 13 14 (f) The Mason County Juvenile Board and the juvenile boards 15 of one or more counties that are adjacent to or in close proximity to Mason County may agree to operate together. Juvenile boards 16 17 operating together may appoint one fiscal officer to receive and disburse funds for the boards. 18 19 SECTION 4. Section 152.1701, Human Resources Code, is 20 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 21 (f) The Menard County Juvenile Board and the juvenile boards 22 of one or more counties that are adjacent to or in close proximity 23 to Menard County may agree to operate together. Juvenile boards 24 operating together may appoint one fiscal officer to receive and disburse funds for the boards. 25 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
