AN ACT

2 relating to certain comprehensive development agreements of the
3 Texas Department of Transportation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 223, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 223.2012 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 223.2012. NO EFFECT ON DEPARTMENT OBLIGATIONS. Any
8 authority for the department to enter into a comprehensive
9 development agreement relating to improvements to Grand Parkway
10 (State Highway 99) does not affect the obligation of the department
11 to comply with the applicable requirements of an agreement entered
12 into under Section 228.0111 in connection with the Grand Parkway
13 project, including complying with the terms and conditions for the
14 development, construction, and operation of the Grand Parkway that
15 are prescribed in such an agreement.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
