18 (j-1) At least two bailiffs shall be assigned regularly to

19 the County Criminal Courts Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of

20 Tarrant County. Except as provided by Subsection (j-2), each judge

21 shall appoint one officer to act as the bailiff of the judge's

22 court, and the sheriff of Tarrant County shall appoint a bailiff for

23 each court as prescribed by law. A bailiff appointed under this

24 subsection serves at the pleasure of the court and shall perform the

- 3 (j-2) The judge of a county criminal court listed in
- 4 Subsection (j) or (j-1) may authorize the sheriff to appoint all
- 5 bailiffs in the judge's court. If the sheriff is authorized by a
- 6 judge to make the judge's appointment under this subsection, the
- 7 sheriff shall appoint at least two officers to act as bailiffs for
- 8 the judge's court. A bailiff appointed under this subsection
- 9 serves at the pleasure of the court and shall perform the duties
- 10 required by the judge of the court to which the bailiff is assigned.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
