SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 164.102, Occupations 18 Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 20 (b) Except on an express determination, based on substantial evidence, that granting probation is in the best 21 interests of the public and of the person whose license has been 22 23 suspended, revoked, or canceled, the board may not grant probation to a person whose license has been canceled, revoked, or suspended 24 because of a felony conviction under: 25 (1) Chapter 481 or 483, Health and Safety Code; 26 Section 485.033, Health and Safety Code; [or] 27 (2)

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(3) the Comprehensive Drug Abuse Prevention 1 and Control Act of 1970 (21 U.S.C. Section 801 et seq.); or 2 (4) any of the following sections of the Penal Code: 3 (A) Section 22.011(a)(2) (sexual assault of a 4 5 child); (B) Section 22.021(a)(1)(B) (aggravated sexual 6 <u>assault of a child);</u> 7 8 (C) Section 21.02 (continuous sexual abuse of a young child or children); or 9 10 (D) Section 21.11 (indecency with a child). SECTION 4. (a) Subsection Section 11 (c), 164.057, and Section 164.0595, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, and 12 Section 164.102, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, apply 13 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this 14 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before 15 16 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before that date. 17 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this 18 19 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,

20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
