BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.021, Local Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to 6 read as follows: 7 8 Regardless of Subsection (a), the extraterritorial (b) 9 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is 10 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that is located: 11 12 (1) within five miles of those boundaries on \underline{a} [the] 13 barrier island; or 14 (2) within one-half mile of those boundaries off a 15 barrier island. 16 (c) Subsection (b) applies to a [if the] municipality that 17 has: 18 (1) a population of 2,000 or more; and 19 territory located: (2) 20 (A) entirely on a barrier island in the Gulf of 21 Mexico; and within 30 miles of an international border. 22 (B) SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24
