2 relating to the extent of extraterritorial jurisdiction of certain  
3 less populous municipalities located on a barrier island.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 42.021, Local Government Code, is  
6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to  
7 read as follows:

8 (b) Regardless of Subsection (a), the extraterritorial  
9 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is  
10 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that  
11 is located:

12 (1) within five miles of those boundaries on a [the]  
13 barrier island; or

14 (2) within one-half mile of those boundaries off a  
15 barrier island.

16 (c) Subsection (b) applies to a [if the] municipality that  
17 has:

18 (1) a population of 2,000 or more; and

19 (2) territory located:

20 (A) entirely on a barrier island in the Gulf of  
21 Mexico; and

22 (B) within 30 miles of an international border.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
