- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 30, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 30.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 30.018. COURT CLERK'S EXECUTION DOCKET. (a) The
- 8 clerk of a court who is required to enter information into an
- 9 execution docket under the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure or other
- 10 law may enter and maintain the information in an electronic format
- 11 that allows the information to be retrieved on the same basis as
- 12 information would be retrieved manually using an index or
- 13 cross-index to the docket that is otherwise required by law.
- (b) Notwithstanding Section 22.004, Government Code, the
- 15 supreme court may not amend or adopt rules in conflict with this
- 16 <u>section</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 34.03, Tax Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (c) The clerk shall note on the execution docket in each
- 20 case the amount of the excess proceeds, the date they were received,
- 21 and the date they were transmitted to the taxing units
- 22 participating in the sale. Any local government record data may be
- 23 stored electronically in addition to or instead of source documents
- 24 in paper or other media.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
