4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2054, Government Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subchapter N to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER N. CYBERSECURITY, EDUCATION,  
8 AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

9 Sec. 2054.501. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "council"  
10 means the Cybersecurity, Education, and Economic Development  
11 Council.

12 Sec. 2054.502. CYBERSECURITY, EDUCATION, AND ECONOMIC  
13 DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL; COMPOSITION. (a) The Cybersecurity,  
14 Education, and Economic Development Council is established.

15 (b) The council is composed of nine members appointed by the  
16 executive director. The members must include:

- 17 (1) one representative from the department;
- 18 (2) one representative from the Texas Economic  
19 Development and Tourism Office in the office of the governor;
- 20 (3) two representatives from institutions of higher  
21 education with cybersecurity-related programs;
- 22 (4) one representative from a public junior college,  
23 as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, with a  
24 cybersecurity-related program;

1           (5) one state military forces liaison experienced in  
2 the cybersecurity field; and

3           (6) three representatives from chamber of commerce  
4 organizations or businesses who have a cybersecurity background.

5           (c) The council shall elect a presiding officer from among  
6 its members.

7           (d) A council member serves at the pleasure of the executive  
8 director.

9           Sec. 2054.503. COMPENSATION. A council member serves  
10 without compensation or reimbursement of expenses.

11           Sec. 2054.504. COUNCIL POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The council  
12 shall:

13           (1) at least quarterly, meet at the call of the  
14 presiding officer; and

15           (2) conduct an interim study and make recommendations  
16 to the executive director regarding:

17           (A) improving the infrastructure of this state's  
18 cybersecurity operations with existing resources and through  
19 partnerships between government, business, and institutions of  
20 higher education; and

21           (B) examining specific actions to accelerate the  
22 growth of cybersecurity as an industry in this state.

23           (b) The council may request the assistance of state  
24 agencies, departments, or offices to carry out its duties.

25           Sec. 2054.505. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2012, the  
26 council shall submit a report based on its findings to:

27           (1) the executive director;

1           (2) the governor;

2           (3) the lieutenant governor;

3           (4) the speaker of the house of representatives;

4           (5) the higher education committees of the senate and  
5 house of representatives;

6           (6) the Senate Committee on Economic Development;

7           (7) the House Technology Committee; and

8           (8) the House Economic and Small Business Development  
9 Committee.

10          Sec. 2054.506. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter  
11 expires and the council is abolished September 1, 2013.

12          SECTION 2. Not later than the 30th day after the effective  
13 date of this Act, the executive director of the Department of  
14 Information Resources shall appoint the members of the  
15 Cybersecurity, Education, and Economic Development Council as  
16 established by Subchapter N, Chapter 2054, Government Code, as  
17 added by this Act.

18          SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
