7	and paying \$893 million in wage income; and
8	WHEREAS, South of Galveston, between Calhoun and Cameron
9	Counties, Texas is home to several growing cities, robust tourism,
10	and a wealth of natural resources; the area also hosts three major
11	deepwater ports, any of which might be a viable site for a cruise
12	line headquarters or a port of embarkation; and
13	WHEREAS, Florida and California, respectively, benefit the
14	most from the North American cruise industry; both states currently
15	operate five ports, including Port Canaveral, Port Everglades,
16	Jacksonville, Miami, and Tampa in Florida, and Los Angeles, Long
17	Beach, San Diego, San Francisco, and Oakland in California; an
18	additional Texas cruise ship port between Calhoun and Cameron
19	Counties could offer an attractive vacation option for a
