6 symbolic troubadours of our state, reflect in rhythm and rhyme the
7 essence of Texan culture; and

8 WHEREAS, The mission of the Texas Heritage Songwriters'
9 Association is to honor and celebrate Texas songwriters who have
10 played an important role in defining and interpreting Texas'
11 distinctive culture; and

12 WHEREAS, The Texas Heritage Songwriters' Association has, in
13 the interest of cultural preservation, adopted the motto "Music in
14 its purest State" and created and fostered the Texas Heritage
15 Songwriters Hall of Fame; and

16 WHEREAS, The Texas Heritage Songwriters' Association has
17 instituted Homecoming Weekend, held each year in conjunction with
18 Texas Independence Day, as a way to celebrate Texas' rich music
19 culture and unique heritage; and

20 WHEREAS, Texas Heritage Songwriters' Association plays a
21 major role in preserving the future of Texas songwriting through
22 its partnerships with Texas universities in their support of young
23 songwriters; it further protects our musical heritage by
