2 WHEREAS, Stacy Furdek of Lubbock passed away on May 26, 2011,
3 at the age of 45, leaving her circle of family and friends to
4 cherish their many happy memories of time spent in her company; and

5 WHEREAS, The daughter of Jim and Diana Richards, the former
6 Stacy Rene Richards was born in Lubbock on October 29, 1965; she
7 graduated from Odessa Permian High School and earned her master's
8 degree in English/American literature from Texas Tech University;
9 after teaching English at Mackenzie Middle School, she joined the
10 faculty at Frenship High School, and she also taught at the Smith
11 Unit in Lamesa; her experience there led her to work with the
12 Lubbock County Jail to develop a GED program for prisoners; in
13 addition, she was a freelance writer and was conducting research
14 for a book on women on death row; and

15 WHEREAS, She married Stephen Furdek in Lubbock on June 1,
16 1998, and welcomed his son, Nicholas, as her first child; on August
17 16, 2000, the couple became the parents of Christopher, who
18 inherited his mother's blue eyes and blond hair; Stacy Furdek was
19 devoted to her children and adored taking Christopher to see his
20 grandmother and on camping trips; generous and compassionate, she
21 reached out to those who were suffering and offered love and hope to
22 all those in need; any stray pet who came her way found a new home
23 and tender care, and she instilled concern for the well-being of
24 animals in her sons; and

1 WHEREAS, Stacy Furdek brought joy to innumerable people
2 through her wonderful sense of humor and great kindness; although
3 she will be deeply missed, she will forever hold a special place in
4 the hearts of those who were fortunate enough to know her; now,
