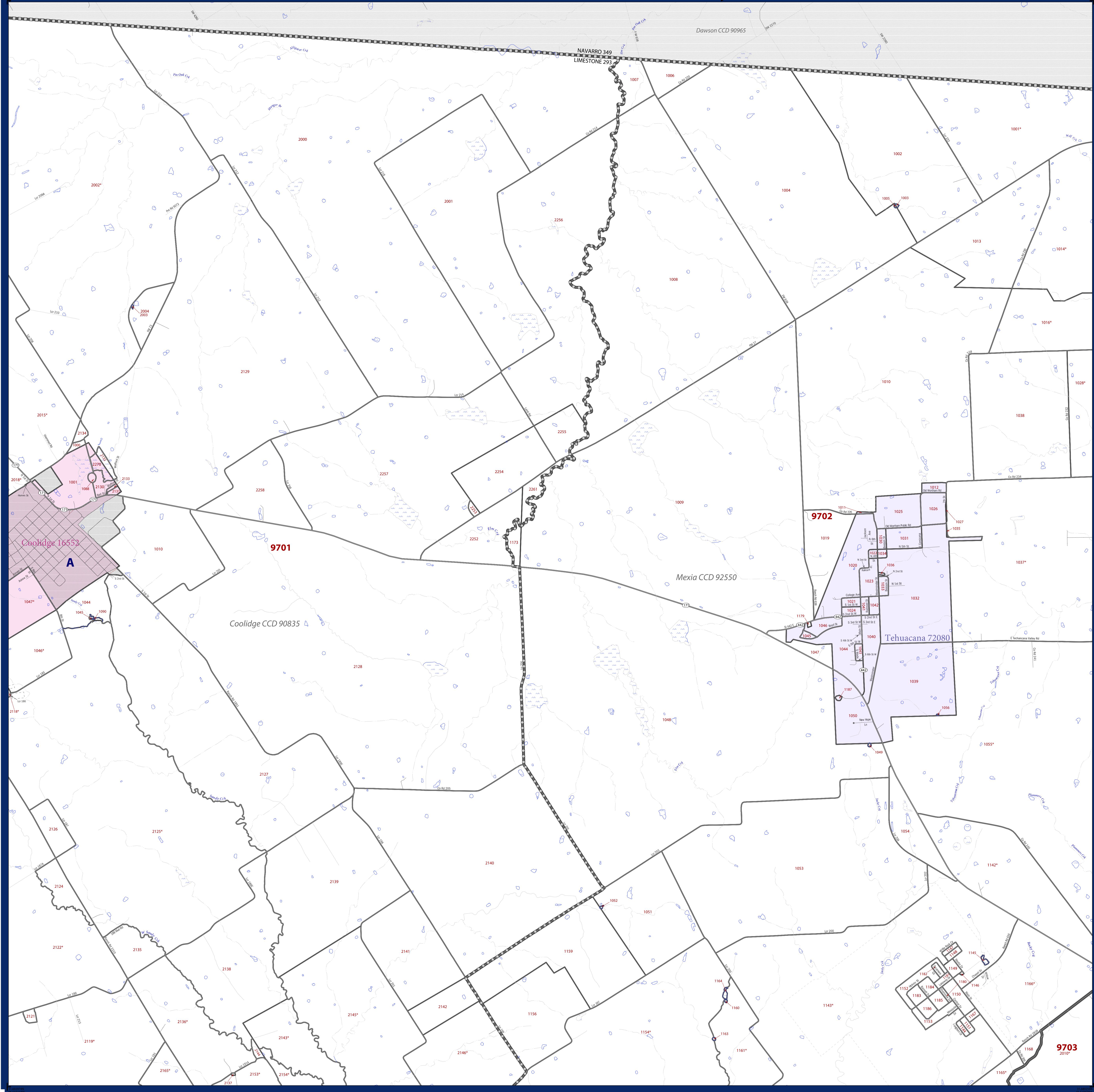

2 Place label color correlates to the place fill color.

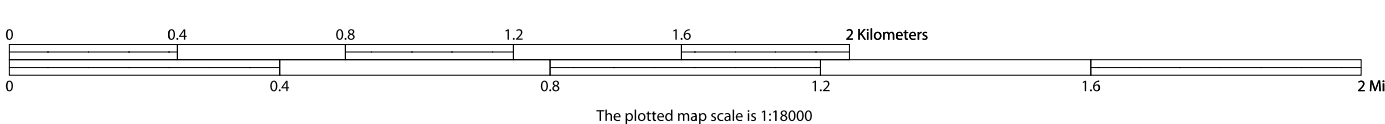
3 A * following a block number indicates that the block number is repeated elsewhere in the block.

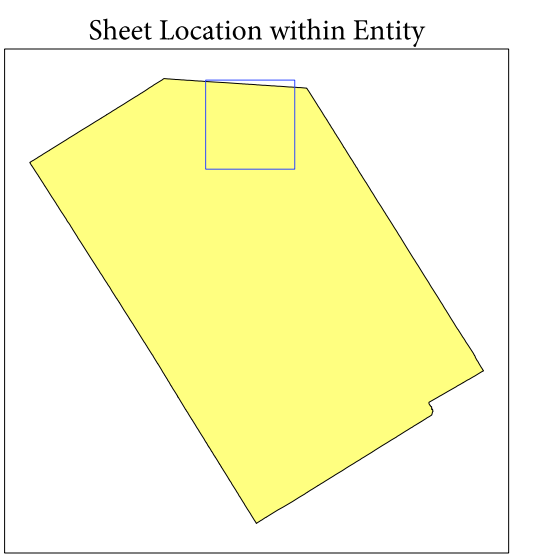
