3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 34.041, Civil Practice and Remedies 4 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 34.041. SALE AT PLACE OTHER THAN COURTHOUSE DOOR. 7 (a) If the public sale of <u>real property</u> [<del>land</del>] is required by <u>court</u> 8 order or other law to be made at a place other than the courthouse 9 door, sales under this chapter shall be made at the place designated 10 by that court order or other law. 11 (b) The commissioners court of a county may designate an area other than an area at the county courthouse where public sales 12 13 of real property under this chapter will take place that is in a 14 public place within a reasonable proximity of the county courthouse as determined by the commissioners court and in a location as 15 16 accessible to the public as the courthouse door. The commissioners 17 court shall record that designation in the real property records of the county. A designation by a commissioners court under this 18 19 section is not a ground for challenging or invalidating any sale. 20 Except for a sale under Subsection (a), a sale must be held at an 21 area designated under this subsection if the sale is held on or 22 after the 90th day after the date the designation is recorded. The commissioners court may by order authorize a county official or 23 24 employee to identify separate locations within the designated area

A 9 sale must be held at an area designated under this subsection if the 10 sale is held on or after the 90th day after the date the designation is recorded [If the commissioners court designates an area in the 11 12 courthouse or another location in the county for sales, a sale must 13 occur in that area or at that location. If the commissioners court 14 does not designate an area in the courthouse or another location in 15 the county for sales, a sale must occur in the same area in the 16 courthouse that is designated by the commissioners court for the sale of real property under Section 51.002, Property Code]. 17

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
