Section 142.013(d), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 Donations to the business leave time account of an 8 employee organization by its members may be authorized in one of the 9 following ways: (1) if the majority of the membership of the employee 10 organization has not affirmatively voted to require contributions 11 12 by the employee organization's members to its business leave time 13 account: 14 (A) a [The] police officer must authorize the 15 donation in writing on a form provided by the employee organization and approved by the municipality; and 16 (B) after[-- After] receiving 17 18 authorization on an approved form, the municipality shall transfer 19 donated time to the account monthly until the municipality receives the police officer's written revocation of the authorization; or 20 21 (2) if the majority of the membership of the employee 22 organization has affirmatively voted to require contributions by 23 the employee organization's members to its business leave time 24 account:

- 1 (A) except as provided by Paragraph (C), the 2 municipality shall transfer donated time to the employee 3 organization's business leave time account from the accumulated 4 vacation or compensatory time of each police officer who is a member of the employee organization in the amount approved by vote of the 5 6 employee organization not to exceed the amount allowed under Subsection (c); 7 8 (B) the municipality shall transfer the donated 9 time to the account monthly beginning with the first calendar month 10 that begins after the date of the employee organization vote
- 11 requiring contributions; and 12 (C) each year, during the period beginning on the 13 60th day before the anniversary of the first day of the first calendar month in which donations were first transferred to the 14 15 business leave time account of the employee organization under 16 Paragraph (B) and ending on the 30th day before that anniversary, a 17 police officer who is a member of the employee organization may inform the municipality in writing on a form provided by the 18 employee organization and approved by the municipality that the 19 20 police officer chooses to not donate time to the account during the 12-month period beginning with that anniversary. 21
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 142.013(i), Local Government Code, is 23 repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 24
