4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 31.126(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Venue for an alleged violation or offense under the
8	provisions of this chapter is in the justice $court_{L}$ [or] county
9	court, or municipal court having jurisdiction where the violation
10	or offense was committed.
11	SECTION 2. Section 31.126(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, as
12	amended by this Act, applies only to a violation that occurs or an
13	offense that is committed on or after the effective date of this
14	Act. A violation that occurs or an offense that is committed before
15	the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when
16	the violation occurred or the offense was committed, and the former
17	law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
18	section, a violation occurs or an offense is committed before the
19	effective date of this Act if any element of the violation or
20	offense occurs or is committed before that date.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
