Subsection (f), Section 132.001, Civil Practice 17 and Remedies Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an unsworn 18 declaration executed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 19 unsworn declaration executed before the effective date of this Act 20 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective 21 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that 22 23 purpose. 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
