- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 361.126, Health and 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission may issue a permit by rule to authorize
- 8 the governing body of a county or municipality with a population of
- 9 $\underline{12,000}$ [$\underline{10,000}$] or less to dispose of demolition waste from a
- 10 building if the disposal occurs on land that:
- 11 (1) the county or municipality owns or controls; and
- 12 (2) would qualify for an arid exemption under
- 13 commission rules.

- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
