- 7 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 61.833, Education Code,
- 8 is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) This section applies to a student enrolled in a general
- 10 academic teaching institution who:
- 11 (1) transferred to the institution from or previously
- 12 attended a lower-division institution of higher education;
- 13 (2) earned at least 30 credit hours for course work
- 14 successfully completed at the lower-division institution of higher
- 15 education; and
- 16 (3) has earned a cumulative total of at least 66 [90]
- 17 credit hours for course work successfully completed.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Subsection
- 19 (b), Section 61.833, Education Code, applies beginning with the
- 20 2013 fall semester. A semester or other academic term before the
- 21 2013 fall semester is covered by the applicable law as it existed
- 22 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is
- 23 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013._
