

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Norteno music legend Ramon Ayala is visiting the
2 State Capitol on May 15, 2013, in celebration of his 50th year in
3 music, and this occasion provides an ideal opportunity to recognize
4 this acclaimed accordionist, songwriter, and singer; and

5 WHEREAS, A longtime resident of Hidalgo, Mr. Ayala was born
6 in Monterrey, Mexico, on December 8, 1945; he took up his signature
7 instrument at the age of six and helped support his family with his
8 playing; as a teenager, he teamed with Cornelio Reyna to form Los
9 Relampagos del Norte, which synthesized traditional norteno music
10 with more modern elements from Texas conjunto; their brilliant
11 fusion defined norteno in the 1960s, and their many hits, including
12 "Ya No Llores" and "El Disgusto," have been covered by countless
13 other artists through the years; and

14 WHEREAS, Los Relampagos recorded 20 albums before the members
15 parted ways in 1971; subsequently, the accordion virtuoso found
16 even greater success leading Ramon Ayala y Sus Bravos del Norte;
17 songs such as "Un Rinconcito en el Cielo," "Chaparra de Mi Amor,"
18 and "Tragos Amargos" became norteno standards, and Mr. Ayala has
19 remained much in demand as a performer, on stage, on television, and
20 in more than a dozen movies; and

21 WHEREAS, Nominated for several Grammy Awards, Mr. Ayala won
22 the honor in the Best Mexican-American Album category in 2001 for
23 *En Vivo... El Hombre Y Su Musica*, and he produced the 2010 Best
24 Norteno Album winner, *Classic*, a tribute to Los Relampagos by
25 contemporary superstars Intocable; Mr. Ayala has also received two

1 Latin Grammys, and in 1997, Los Relampagos was inducted into the
2 Pura Vida Music Hall of Fame; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Ayala has demonstrated a deep commitment to his
4 community, and in 2000, he sponsored the first Ramon Ayala
5 Christmas Posada, an event highlighted by a toy giveaway for area
6 children; the presents delight some 10,000 youngsters annually and
7 are an especially treasured holiday tradition for those from
8 disadvantaged backgrounds; and

9 WHEREAS, The posada also includes a mass and a Nativity
10 reenactment, and the day comes to an exciting close when the man
11 known as "El Rey del Accordeon"--the "King of the Accordion"--joins
12 with other performers to present a free concert; the event was moved
13 from his hometown of Hidalgo to the community of Las Milpas in 2012;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Ramon Ayala has made vital contributions to Texas
16 music through his innovations and artistry, and while delighting
17 countless Tejano fans over the course of his career, he has been
18 equally devoted to bringing the joy of the holiday season to all
19 members of his community; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas
21 hereby declare May 15, 2013, as Ramon Ayala Day at the State Capitol
22 and congratulate Mr. Ayala on his 50th anniversary in music; and,
23 be it further

24 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
25 prepared for Mr. Ayala as an expression of high regard by the Texas
26 House of Representatives and Senate.
