3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 104.103, Utilities Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
6	follows:
7	(b) Instead of publishing newspaper notice, a gas utility
8	may provide notice [to the public in an area outside the affected
9	municipality or in a municipality with a population of less than
10	2,500] by:
11	(1) mailing the notice by United States mail, postage
12	prepaid, to the billing address of each directly affected customer;
13	[or]
14	(2) including the notice, in conspicuous form, in the
15	bill of each directly affected customer; or
16	(3) sending the notice by e-mail to each directly
17	affected customer if that address is available to the utility.
18	(c) A gas utility may provide a customer with notice of the
19	utility's intent to increase rates by e-mail as described by
20	Subsection (b)(3) only if the customer has consented in writing to
21	the use of the customer's e-mail address for that purpose.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to a notice of a proposed utility rate increase provided on or after
24	the effective date of this Act. Notice provided before the

l effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed

2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is

3 continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
