5	SECTION 1. Section 623.219(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
8	county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission
9	shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most
10	direct route from:
11	(1) the Gateway International Bridge or the Veterans
12	International Bridge at Los Tomates to the entrance of the Port of
13	Brownsville using State Highways 48 and 4 or United States Highways
14	77 and 83 or using United States Highway 77 and United States
15	Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State Highway 4; and
16	(2) the Free Trade International Bridge to the
17	entrance of the Port of Brownsville using Farm-to-Market Road 509,
18	United States Highways 77 and 83, Farm-to-Market Road 511, State
19	Highway 550, and East Loop (State Highway 32).

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
