5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

9	commissioners court of each county in the Second Court of Appeals

14	county courts, statutory county courts, <u>statutory</u> probate courts,
15	and district courts; and
16	(2) defray costs and expenses incurred <u>in the</u>
17	operation of the court of appeals [by the county under Section
18	22.203].
19	(b) To fund the system, the commissioners court <u>shall</u> [may]
20	set a court costs fee of [not more than] \$5 for each civil suit filed
21	in county court, statutory county court, <u>statutory</u> probate court,
22	or district court in the county.
22	(c) The court costs fee does not apply to a suit filed by any

(c) The court costs fee does not apply to a suit filed by <u>any</u>
<u>governmental entity</u> [the county] or to a suit for delinquent taxes.

1 (d) The court costs fee shall be taxed, collected, and paid 2 as other court costs in a suit. The clerk of the court shall collect the court costs fee set under this section and pay it to the county 3 4 officer who performs the county treasurer's functions. That officer shall deposit the fee in a separate appellate judicial 5 6 [justice] system fund for [. The commissioners court shall 7 establish and maintain the fund to assist] the court of appeals 8 district. The fund may not be used for any other purpose.

9 (e) The [commissioners court shall annually order the] 10 funds collected under this section <u>must</u> [to] be forwarded <u>monthly</u> 11 to the court of appeals for expenditure by the court of appeals [for 12 its judicial system].

13 (f) The [commissioners court shall vest-management of the system in the] chief justice of the court of appeals is responsible 14 15 for management of the funds forwarded to the court of appeals under this section and has sole discretion as to the use of the funds, 16 17 except that the funds must be used for purposes consistent with the 18 purposes of the appellate judicial system as described by 19 Subsection (a). [The commissioners court has the authority 20 necessary to assist the court of appeals in the administration and 21 management of the system and to contract with any private 22 corporation, public corporation, or a combination of those 23 corporations.]

6 (b) The imposition or change in the amount of a fee imposed 7 under a provision listed in Subsection (a) of this section applies only to a civil suit filed in a county court, statutory county 8 court, statutory probate court, or district court on or after the 9 10 effective date of this Act. A civil suit filed in a county court, statutory county court, statutory probate court, or district court 11 12 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 13 14 purpose.
