- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 641.051, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) This section does not apply to a person engaged in radio
- 8 or television broadcasting who transfers, or causes to be
- 9 transferred, a recording:
- 10 (1) intended for or in connection with a radio or
- 11 television broadcast; or
- 12 (2) for archival purposes.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 641.051, Business & Commerce Code, does not apply to an offense
- 15 committed under that section before the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by that section as it existed on the date the offense was
- 18 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed
- 20 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 21 occurred before that date.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
