9 a fiscal year in which district net revenues exceed expenditures by

10 \$10,000 or less, may submit to the executive director of the Texas

11 Commission on Environmental Quality a compilation report or a

12 review report instead of an audited financial statement.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

17 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
