- SECTION 2. Section 1702.1183, Occupations Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 12 (c) The board shall adopt rules under which the board may
- 13 waive any prerequisite to obtaining a license for, and credit
- 14 experience for a license requirement to, an individual who the
- 15 board determines has acceptable experience gained during service in
- 16 a branch of the United States armed forces, including the United
- 17 States Coast Guard.
- 18 SECTION 3. The Texas Private Security Board shall adopt
- 19 rules to implement Section 1702.1183(c), Occupations Code, as added
- 20 by this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 21 Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
