

1 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, made by this Act and an
2 amendment to that chapter made by another Act of the 83rd
3 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, are irreconcilable, it is the
4 intent of the legislature that the amendment to Chapter 356 (H.B.
5 1232), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, made by
6 this Act prevail, regardless of the relative effective dates or
7 dates of enactment of the irreconcilable amendments.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
13 legislative session.
