1 that is made in a reporting period beginning on or after March 1, 2 2014. A report made under Section 98.103, Health and Safety Code, 3 during a reporting period that begins before March 1, 2014, is 4 covered by the law in existence on the date the reporting period 5 began, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

6 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies to a 7 departmental summary published under Section 98.106, Health and 8 Safety Code, that covers a reporting period beginning on or after 9 March 1, 2014. A departmental summary that covers a reporting 10 period that begins before March 1, 2014, is covered by the law in 11 existence on the date the reporting period began, and the former law 12 is continued in effect for that purpose.
