7	Sec. 29.920. WINTER CELEBRATIONS. (a) A school district
8	may educate students about the history of traditional winter
9	celebrations, and allow students and district staff to offer
10	traditional greetings regarding the celebrations, including:
11	(1) "Merry Christmas";
12	(2) "Happy Hanukkah"; and
13	(3) "happy holidays."
14	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a school district
15	may display on school property scenes or symbols associated with
16	traditional winter celebrations, including a menorah or a Christmas
17	image such as a nativity scene or Christmas tree, if the display
18	includes a scene or symbol of:
19	(1) more than one religion; or
20	(2) one religion and at least one secular scene or
21	symbol.
22	(c) A display relating to a traditional winter celebration
23	may not include a message that encourages adherence to a particular
24	religious belief.

- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
