7	(b-1) If [Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the requirements
8	of Subsection (b) apply only if] the individual whose sensitive
9	personal information was or is reasonably believed to have been
10	acquired by an unauthorized person is a resident [of this state or
11	another state that does not require a person described by
12	Subsection (b) to notify the individual of a breach of system
13	security. If the individual is a resident] of a state that
14	requires a person described by Subsection (b) to provide notice of a
15	breach of system security, the notice of the breach of system
16	security required under Subsection (b) may be provided under that
17	state's law or under [satisfies the requirements of] Subsection
18	(b).
19	(e) A person may give notice as required by Subsection (b)
20	or (c) by providing:
21	(1) written notice at the last known address of the
