Section 306.003, Government Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 8 (c) If a member of the legislature or the lieutenant 9 governor discloses to the Department of Family and Protective Services or a governmental unit that is a "covered entity" under 10 Section 181.001(b), Health and Safety Code, all or part of a record 11 to which Subsection (a) applies or communicates to the department 12 or governmental unit a description of the information contained in 13 14 the record that identifies or would tend to identify the resident of 15 this state who communicated with the member or lieutenant governor, the record or the described information, as applicable, in the 16 17 possession of the department or governmental unit is subject to and confidential under Subsection (a) and may be disclosed to any other 18 19 person only to the extent that the member of the legislature or 20 lieutenant governor elects to disclose the record or the described 21 information. (d) If the department or governmental unit that is a 22 23 "covered entity" under Section 181.001(b), Health and Safety Code, receives a request for public information under Chapter 552, and 24

- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
