5	SECTION 1. Section 151.336, Tax Code, is amended to read as
6	follows:
7	Sec. 151.336. CERTAIN COINS AND PRECIOUS METALS. [ <del>(a)</del> ] The
8	sale of gold, silver, or numismatic coins or of platinum, gold, or
9	silver bullion is exempted from the $taxes$ [sales $tax$ ] imposed by
10	this chapter [Subchapter C at any sale to a purchaser in which the
11	total sales price of all of the items sold equals \$1,000 or more].
12	[(b) -An item exempt under Subsection (a) is exempt from the
13	use tax imposed by Subchapter D to the purchaser until the item is
14	subsequently transferred.
15	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
16	affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
17	Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
18	enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
19	collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
20	the liability for those taxes.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
