

CHAPTER 845

H.B. No. 138

1 AN ACT

2 relating to funding for certain commercial service airport
3 projects.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 21, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 21.115 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 21.115. FUNDING FOR CERTAIN COMMERCIAL SERVICE
8 AIRPORTS. To the extent consistent with federal funding
9 restrictions, a project involving a commercial service airport is
10 eligible for financial assistance under this subchapter, including
11 for inclusion in the aviation facilities capital improvement
12 program, if the airport is located in a county along the
13 Texas-Mexico border that has a population of less than 300,000.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
