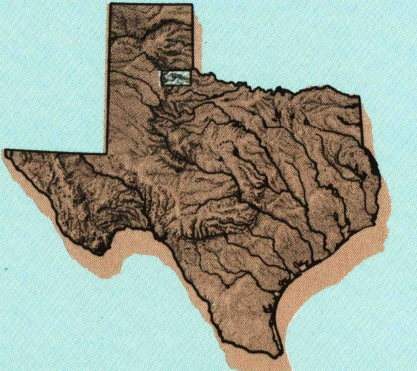


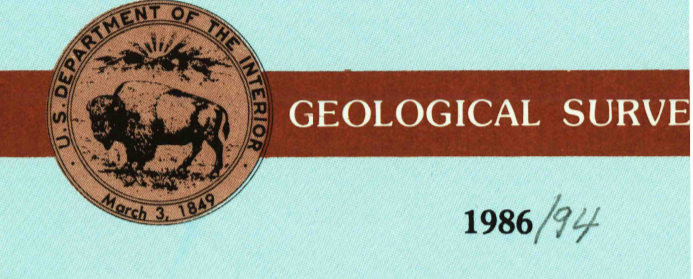


# Childress TEXAS
