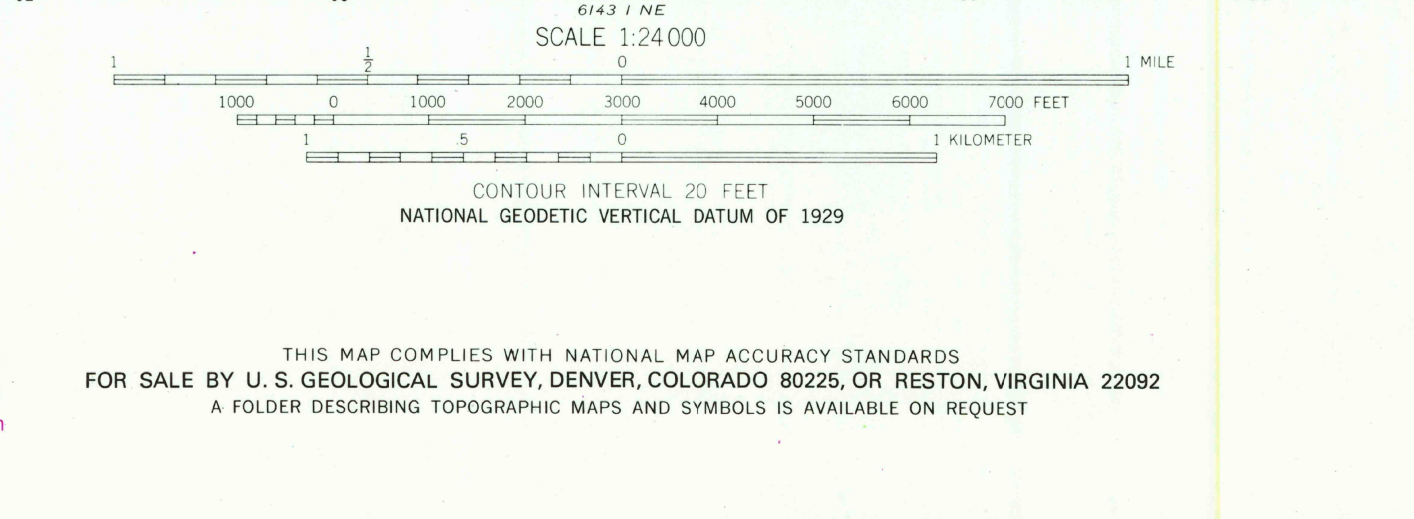

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 18 meters north and 31 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
