

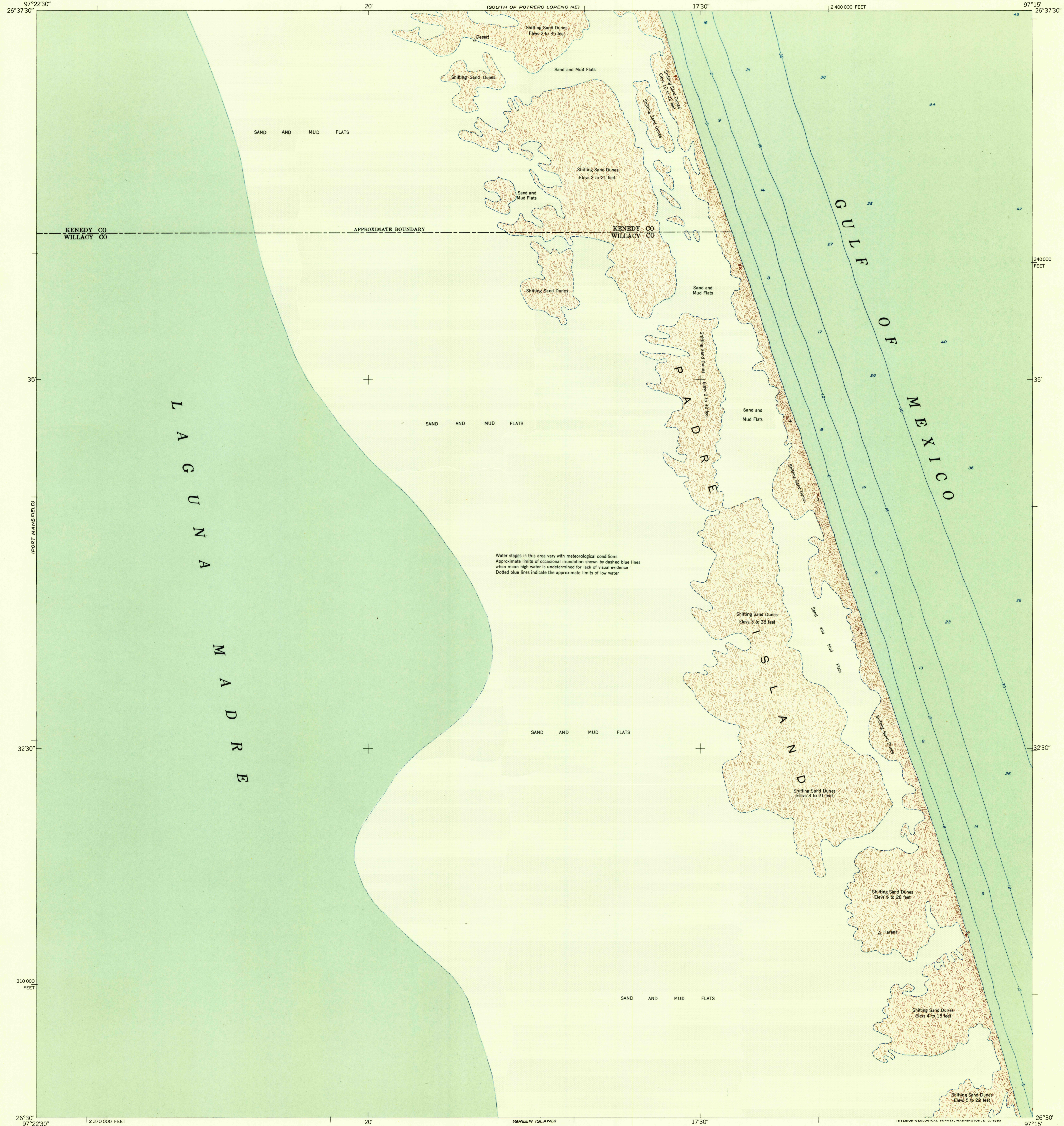

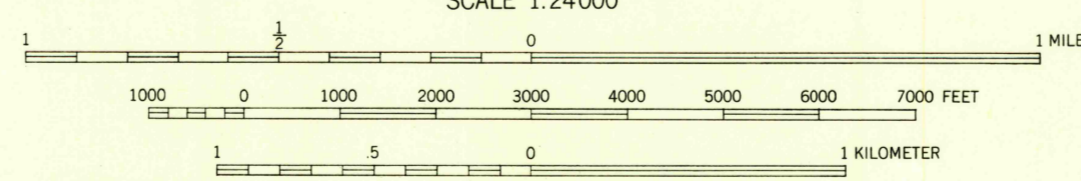
SOUTH OF POTRERO LOPENO SE QUADRANGLE
