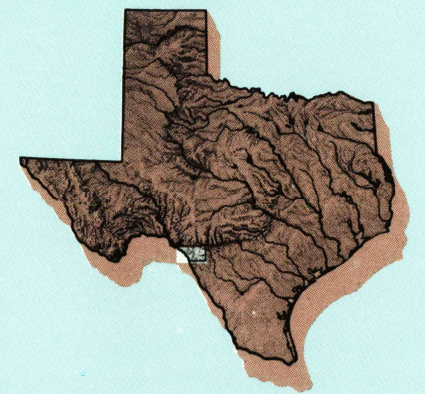


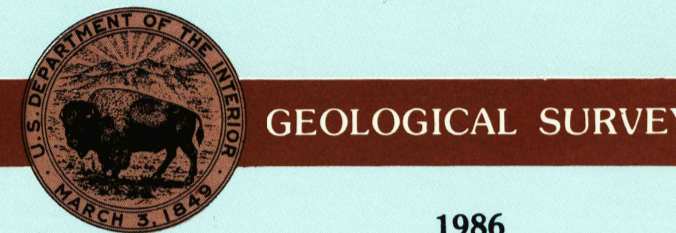
# Del Rio TEXAS
