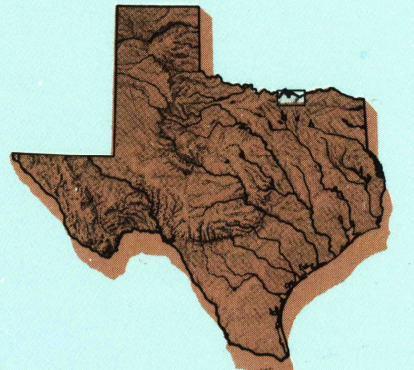


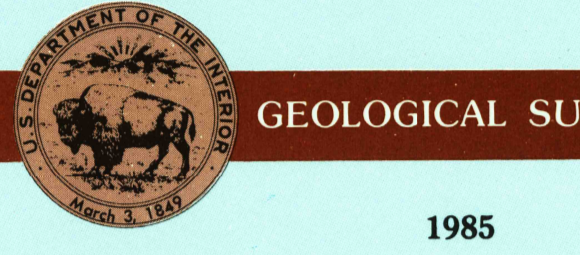
Sherman TEXAS—OKLAHOMA
