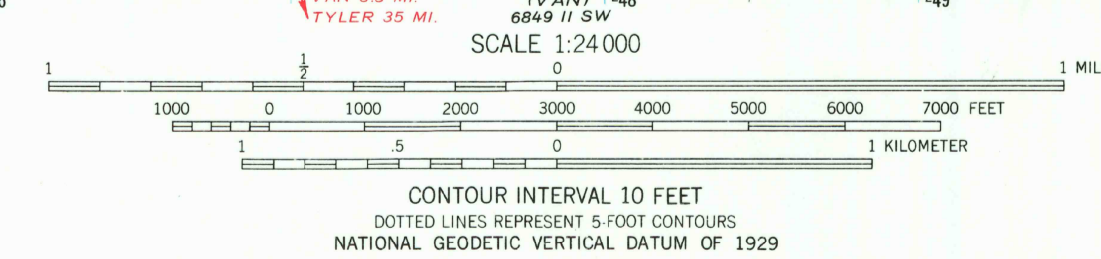

landmark buildings are shown  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 11 meters south and  
23 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas
