

To the Honorable Thomas F. Nash, Judge of the County Court of Dallas County, sitting in matters Probate:

Your Petitioner, Mrs. Dora Jetton, would respectfully state to the Court, that heretofore, to-wit: on the 30th day of *Sept*, 1870, her husband, *Louis* Jetton, departed this life, leaving surviving him one child, a boy, ^{*Louis Jetton*} whose age is at this time *12*... years; that both your Petitioner and said child are resident citizens of the County of Dallas, State of Texas; that your Petitioner is the mother of said boy, and that he inherited from the estate of his said father the sum of about *Twenty Five* Dollars; that no regular Guardian has ever been appointed for him.

Wherefore, your Petitioner prays that she be allowed to qualify as the Guardian of her said son, and that citation issue to that end.
