State of Texas,

Dallas County. To the Honorable County Court of Dallas County.

Your petitioner, Paul McCombs, a resident of the County of Dallas and State of Texas, respectfully shows to the Court:

That heretofore, on or about the 17th day of July 1904, his wife, Florence Jackson McCombs departed this life in the City of Dallas in the County of Dallas and State of Texas.

That his said wife left surviving her as her sole heirs at law, the following children, to-wit: Mora McCombs, a feme sole, adult; Melvorne McCombs, a minor, and Helen Blazes McCombs, a minor; all three residents of the County of Dallas aforesaid.

That his said wife died testate, leaving a will in which she bequeathed to her said children all the property of which she might be possessed at the time of her death; and that said will is in the possession of Mrs Clara Jackson Crutcher, wife of C. F. Crutcher and sister of said Florence J. McCombs; who resides in said Dallas County.

That said will made no provision for an executor.

That his said wife left an estate consisting of separate and community property, both real and personal; and that said estate is also encumbered with considerable debts, that are probably of equal amount to value of the property; of the value of the estate this petitioner is not aware sufficiently to state.

Wherefore petitioner prays for citation to all the parties aforementioned, with special citation to said Clara J. Crutcher to produce in court said will of Florence J. McCombs for probate; that upon hearing the Court appoint, as Administrator of the estate of his said wife, the Trust Company of Dallas; and appoint petitioner Guardian of the person and estate of said minor, Helen Blazes McCombs; and for such other and further orders as may be necessary, in the premises.
