## ORDER PROBATING WILL

Est Vinginia M E Beaumont, Dec'd \#3924
Entered as of March 10th, 1906
On this day came on to be heard the applioation of Godfrey Beaumont for the probate of a certain instrument now produced in open Court, and purporting and alleged to be the last will and testament of Virginia ME Beaumont, deceased. And said spplication and the evidence thereon being heard and it appearing to the Court that due and legal notice of said applidation has been given and no objection thereto offered. -

And it further appearing to the Court from the written testimony of T. S. Miller, one of the subscribing witnesses to said will, that said Virginia. M.E. Beaumont died in Dallas County, Texas, on the lst dsy of Feby 1906; that he executed said instrument now produced in open Court, in the presence of said T. S. Miller, is Dargen and $T$. R. Pieree subacribing witnesses on the 28 th Aay of February 1906, and declared the same to be her last will and testament, that at $t$ ? time of the execution of said will as aforesaid, safd testatrix wis over the age of 21 years, and of sound mind, and that each of said witnesses were at the time over 14 years of age, that sald will was never revoked by said testatrix; that said witnesses subscribed said will in the presence of and at the request of said testatrix and in the presence of each other.

It is considered by the Court that said instmument be and the same is now here adjudged - be the last will and testament of said Virginia M \& Beaumont, dec̄eased, and admitted to probate as such last will and testsment. And the will and the application for the probete thereof and all the testimony in this case is ordered of record.

It is further ordered that Godfrey Beaumont be and he is horeby confirmed as Independent Executor of said will without bond, as directed in said will and the Clerk will issue to him letters testementary upon his taking and subscribing the oath required by 1 aw .

It is further ordered that L Blaylock, C B G1ilespie and 0 If Terry be and they are herehy appointed appraisers to appraise the estate of said decedent.
