Your petitioner H. S. Dodson, shows to the court that he resides in Dallas County, Texas: That on or about the 26th, day of November, 1903, W. P. Dakan, who resided in Dallas County, Texas, died intestate in said City, and county. That before, and at his death, he had his domicile in said county aforesaid, and was an employee of Kemper & Dodson, Wholesale Grocers, in said city, and of which firm your petitioner is a member. That the said W. P. Dakan, was a single man, never ^{2 yrs. about 30 yrs} having married, and leaves no near relatives.

That at the time of his death the said W. P. Dakan, was seized and possessed of personal property, and effects, of the value of \$155, of which amount \$70, is deposited in the American National Bank, and \$75, due him by the said firm of Kemper & Dodson, for his services. That your petitioner had the said W. P. Dakan, buried, and obligated himself to pay the expenses of the burial, which amounted to about \$150. That there is a necessity of immediate administration upon said estate, in order that said money might be collected and spent to meet the burial expenses, and your petitioner now asks that he be appointed temporary administrator for the ^{Said Estate} ~~property as above stated~~, and to transact all business for the settling up of his affairs. That your petitioner is not disqualified to act as administrator.
