## Texas Lottery® Continues to Support Texas Schools!

In February, the Texas Lottery reached a new landmark—\$14 billion in transfers of funds to the Foundation School Fund (FSF) since 1997!

From 1992 to 1997, proceeds were allocated to the General Revenue Fund. Since then, the Texas Legislature dedicated Texas Lottery revenue to the FSF, which supports public education in Texas. Total transfers to the state from all sales since 1992 exceed \$19 billion.

Approximately 25 cents of every dollar earned by the Texas Lottery goes to the FSF to support Texas education. During Fiscal Year (FY) 2011, which ended August 31, 2011, a total of \$.96 billion was transferred to the FSF.

More than 95 percent of the total sales for FY 2011 returned to the players in prizes,

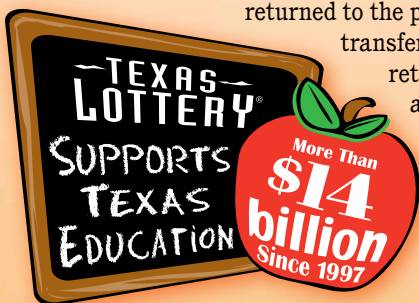

The April 3 *Mega Millions*® drawing turned out to be just the ticket for **Billy W. Plumlee** of **Saratoga**. His Quick Pick ticket matched all five numbers (11 – 35 – 38 – 41 – 52) but not the Mega Ball (40). Because he selected the *Megaplier*® option, his \$250,000 prize was automatically raised to \$1 million.

“I called the hotline and checked the numbers,” said Plumlee, but he couldn’t believe his ears. “I thought it was a mistake.”

A visit to the Texas Lottery® claim center in Beaumont the next day cleared up any confusion when Plumlee claimed his \$1 million prize.

Plumlee says he’s played the Texas Lottery since it began, and he plans to invest a portion of his \$1 million prize. His advice to other players is simple: “Don’t give up.”

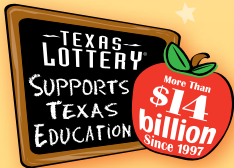
The Millenium Grocery located at 770 S. Pine in Kountze sold Plumlee his lucky ticket.

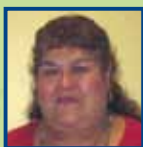

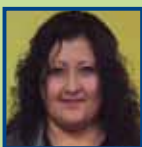

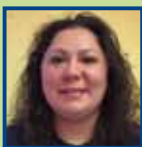
