

It was a record-breaking sales year for the Texas Lottery Commission in fiscal year 2012, which ran from September 1,2011 , to August 31, 2012. Record sales of $\$ 4.19$ billion resulted in a total contribution of $\$ 1.096$ billion to the Foundation School Fund, which supports public education in Texas-an increase of 13.8 percent over last year.
"With sales up 10 percent over last year, this is the ninth consecutive year that the Texas Lottery generated more than $\$ 1$ billion in contributions to the state of Texas," said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. "This is our largest transfer to the Foundation School Fund since 1998."

Also, sales of the Veterans Cash scratch-off games resulted in $\$ 4.7$ million for the Fund for Veterans' Assistance, which is administered by the Texas Veterans Commission. Other

Texas Lottery proceeds, including unclaimed prizes, resulted in a transfer of $\$ 46$ million to the state's General Revenue Fund.
