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DEFINITIONS

Motor Vehicle - Every vehicle which is selfpropelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon rails.

Trafficway - The space within property lines or other boundary lines of any way open to the public as a matter of right or custom for moving persons or property from one place to another.

Accident - An unintended event or unstabilized situation that produces injury or damage (harmful event) not directly resulting from a cataclysm.

In Transport - Denotes the state or condition of a motor vehicle which is in motion or within the portion of a way ordinarily used for travel by similar vehicles. When applied to motor vehicles, in transport means in motion or on a roadway.

Motor Vehicle Accident - An accident involving a motor vehicle in transport, but not involving aircraft or watercraft.

Motor Vehicle Traffic Accident - Any motor vehicle accident that occurs on a trafficway or that occurs after the motor vehicle runs off roadway but before events are stabilized.

Urban Accident - A motor vehicle accident that occurs at a location within the limits of a city having 5,000 or more population.

Rural Accident - A motor vehicle accident that cannot be classified as an urban accident.

TRAFFIC HIGHLIGHTS OF 1987

- The death rate on Texas highways reached the lowest level ever recorded. The death rate was 2.2 deaths per hundred million miles traveled. This is an 8% decrease from the 1986 death rate of 2.4 deaths per hundred million miles traveled. This is the seventh consecutive decrease in the death rate.
- Texas experienced a decrease in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities recorded. The 1987 death toll of 3,261 was a 9% decrease from the 3,568 deaths recorded in 1986. This is the lowest number of deaths recorded since 1976.
- Vehicle miles traveled in Texas during 1987 reached a record high of 151.221 billion, an increase of 0.5% over the 150.474 billion traveled in 1986. This record high number of miles traveled helped produce the low death rate experienced on Texas highways.
- Fatalities in traffic accidents in rural areas of the state accounted for 54% of the state's traffic fatality count. There were 1,759 deaths in rural traffic accidents. This is a 9% decrease from the 1,940 deaths in rural traffic accidents recorded in 1986.
- For the tenth consecutive year, there were no deathless days on Texas highways. There was a decrease in the number of days where there were 20 or more traffic deaths recorded. In 1987, there were 9 days where 20 or more traffic deaths were recorded. In 1986, there were 20 days.
- There were 3 accidents that resulted in 6 or more fatalities in 1987. Eighteen people were killed in these accidents. In two of the accidents, speed or DWI was listed as a contributing factor. Six of the eighteen people killed were reported as wearing seat belts.
- Saturday, April 25, Saturday, June 20 and Saturday, November 14, were the three deadliest days in 1987, with 22 traffic fatalities. The largest number of traffic deaths, 315, was recorded in August and October. This is the fifth year in a row that no month had more than 400 traffic fatalities recorded.
- Based on reported accidents in 1987:
 - 1 person was killed every 2 hours 41 minutes
 - 1 person was injured every 2 minutes 19 seconds
 - 1 reportable accident occurred every 80 seconds
- Of the 254 counties in Texas, 88 recorded an increase in motor vehicle traffic accident deaths during 1987 as compared with 1986.
- Of all the persons killed in passenger cars, trucks, and buses during 1987, 76.1% were not wearing seat belts when the fatal accident occurred. Statistics show that the chance of being killed in an accident during 1987 were more than six times as great for persons not wearing seat belts as for those wearing seat belts.
- 226,895 people were injured in motor vehicle traffic accidents in 1987. Due to changes in report processing persons injured or injury accidents should not be compared prior to 1987.
- In 1987, there were 1,250 people killed in alcohol related motor vehicle traffic accidents. This is a 4% decrease over the 1986 figure of 1,304.
- There were 286 motorcyclists killed in 1987. Of this number, 81% were reported as not wearing helmets. Although Texas law requires motorcyclists under the age of 18 to wear helmets, only 36% of the motorcyclists under 18, who were killed in traffic accidents were reported as wearing helmets.


Note: Beginning with January 1, 1983, a death, from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident, is not counted if it occurs more than 30 days after the accident date. From 1978-1982, fatalities were counted when an injury resulted in death within 90 days of the motor vehicle traffic accident. Previous to 1978, fatalities resulting from an injury accident were counted anytime prior to the statistical cut-off date for the accident year. It should be noted that accident data indicates that about 99% of all deaths from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident occur within 30 days of the accident date.

Prior to 1978, an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person, or TOTAL DAMAGE to the apparent extent of \$25.00 or more had to be reported. Accidents occurring on or after January 1, 1978 resulting in injury to or death of any person, or damage to the property of ANY ONE PERSON to the apparent extent of \$250.00 or more had to be reported. Because of this change in reporting laws, the total number of accidents and the number of non-injury property damage accidents cannot be compared with years prior to 1978.



REPORTED SEAT BELT USAGE IN ACCIDENTS 1984 — 1987



Reported seat belt usage in accidents has been steadily increasing since the implementation of the seat belt law. In 1984, one year prior to the seat belt law, only 4.6% of the occupants in passenger cars, trucks, and buses were **reported** as being belted, that number increased to 72.3% in 1987.

One word of caution, this is **reported** belt use, not observed. Certainly some of the current use rate is attributable to persons falsely indicating they were belted in order to avoid prosecution for failing to wear a seat belt. Peace Officer's reporting of belt use has also improved.







