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DEFINITIONS

Motor Vehicle - Every vehicle which is selfpropelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon rails.

Trafficway - The space within property lines or other boundary lines of any way open to the public as a matter of right or custom for moving persons or property from one place to another.

Accident - An unintended event or unstabilized situation that produces injury or damage (harmful event) not directly resulting from a cataclysm.

In Transport - Denotes the state or condition of a motor vehicle which is in motion or within the portion of a way ordinarily used for travel by similar vehicles. When applied to motor vehicles, in transport means in motion or on a roadway.

Motor Vehicle Accident - An accident involving a motor vehicle in transport, but not involving aircraft or watercraft.

Motor Vehicle Traffic Accident - Any motor vehicle accident that occurs on a trafficway or that occurs after the motor vehicle runs off roadway but before events are stabilized.

Urban Accident - A motor vehicle accident that occurs at a location within the limits of a city having 5,000 or more population.

Rural Accident - A motor vehicle accident that cannot be classified as an urban accident.

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TRAFFIC HIGHLIGHTS OF 1988

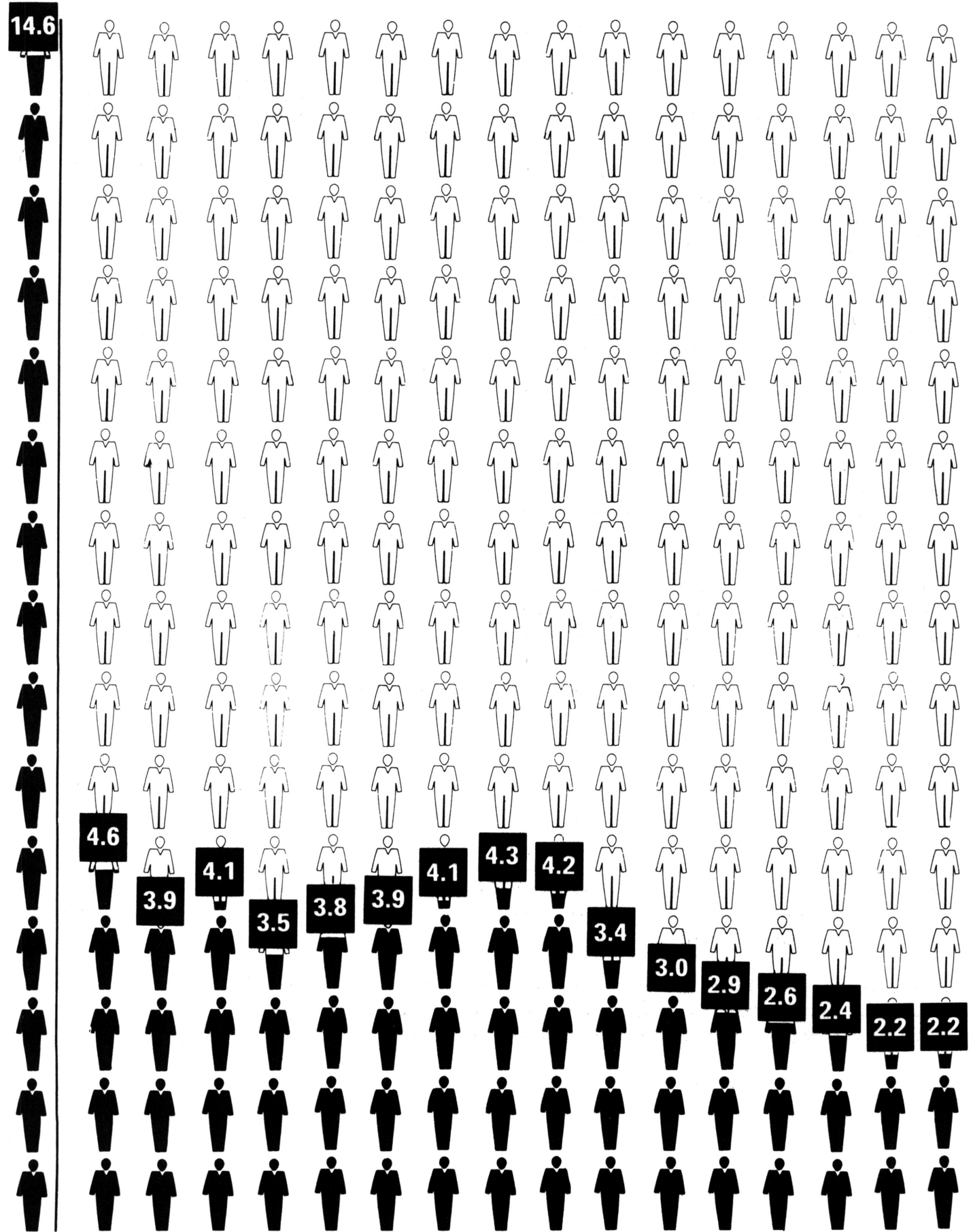
- The death rate on Texas highways remained at the lowest level ever recorded. The death rate was 2.2 deaths per hundred million miles traveled. This is the same death rate as 1987 and breaks a string of seven consecutive years of decrease.
- Texas experienced an increase in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities. The 1988 death toll of 3,395 was a 4% increase from the 3,261 deaths recorded in 1987. This is the first increase in motor vehicle traffic fatalities since 1984.
- Vehicle miles traveled in Texas during 1988 reached a record high of 152.819 billion, an increase of 1% over the 151.221 billion traveled in 1987. The record high number of miles traveled helped produce the same death rate experienced in 1987 even though motor vehicle traffic fatalities were up.
- Fatalities in traffic accidents in rural areas of the state accounted for 57% of the state's traffic fatality count. There were 1,943 deaths in rural traffic accidents. This is a 10% increase from the 1,759 deaths in rural traffic accidents recorded in 1987. This increase in rural fatalities is probably attributable, in part, to the 65mph speed limit. The death toll on rural interstates (including both 65mph and 55mph zoned roads) increased by 20% over 1987. The rural death rate climbed from 2.6 in 1987 to 2.9 deaths per one hundred million vehicle miles driven in 1988, the first increase since 1980. Certainly, one of the primary reasons may well be the 65mph speed limit and the subsequent increase in the speeds traveled in rural areas.
- For the eleventh consecutive year, there were no deathless days on Texas highways. There was an increase in the number of days where there were 20 or more traffic deaths recorded. In 1988, there were 13 days where 20 or more traffic deaths were recorded. In 1987, there were 9 days.
- There were 4 accidents that resulted in 6 or more fatalities in 1988. Twenty-four people were killed in these accidents. In 3 of the accidents speed or DWI was listed as a contributing factor. Two of the twenty-four people killed were reported as wearing seat belts.
- Sunday, October 9, was the deadliest day in 1988, with 30 traffic fatalities. The largest number of traffic deaths, 324, was recorded in October. This is the sixth year in a row that no month had more than 400 traffic fatalities recorded.
- Based on reported accidents in 1988:
 - 1 person was killed every 2 hours 35 minutes
 - 1 person was injured every 2 minutes 12 seconds
 - 1 reportable accident occurred every 81 seconds
- Of the 254 counties in Texas, 120 recorded an increase in motor vehicle traffic accident deaths during 1988 as compared with 1987.
- Of all the persons killed in passenger cars, trucks, and buses during 1988, 77.3% were not wearing seat belts when the fatal accident occurred. Statistics show that the chance of being killed in an accident during 1988 were more than fifteen times as great for persons not wearing seat belts as for those wearing seat belts.
- 238,845 people were injured in motor vehicle traffic accidents in 1988. This is a 5% increase from the 1987 figure of 226,895.
- In 1988, there were 1,363 people killed in alcohol related motor vehicle traffic accidents. This is a 9% increase over the 1987 figure of 1,250.
- There were 295 motorcyclists killed in 1988. Of this number, 78% were reported as not wearing helmets. Although Texas law requires motorcyclists under the age of 18 to wear helmets, only 23% of the motorcyclists under 18, who were killed in traffic accidents were reported as wearing helmets.

Note: Beginning with January 1, 1983, a death, from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident, is not counted if it occurs more than 30 days after the accident date. From 1978-1982, fatalities were counted when an injury resulted in death within 90 days of the motor vehicle traffic accident. Previous to 1978, fatalities resulting from an injury accident were counted anytime prior to the statistical cut-off date for the accident year. It should be noted that accident data indicates that about 99% of all deaths from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident occur within 30 days of the accident date.

Prior to 1978, an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person, or TOTAL DAMAGE to the apparent extent of \$250.00 or more had to be reported. Accidents occurring on or after January 1, 1978 resulting in injury to or death of any person, or damage to the property of ANY ONE PERSON to the apparent extent of \$250.00 or more had to be reported. Because of this change in reporting laws, the total number of accidents and the number of non-injury property damage accidents cannot be compared with years prior to 1978.

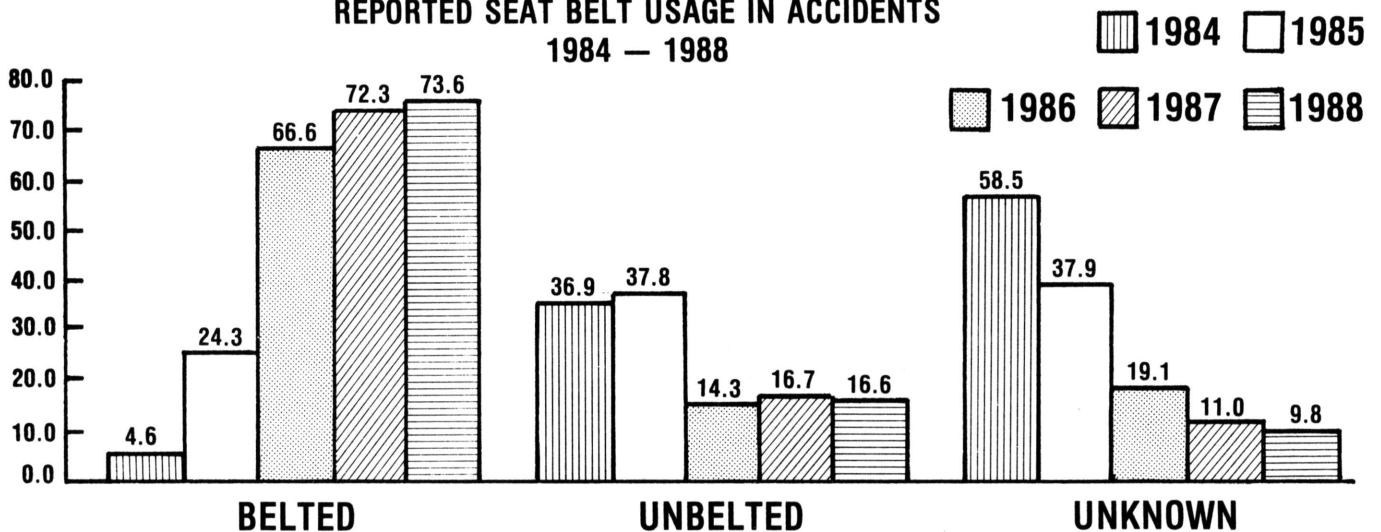

REPORTED SEAT BELT USAGE IN ACCIDENTS 1984 — 1988



Reported seat belt usage in accidents has been steadily increasing since the implementation of the seat belt law. In 1984, one year prior to the seat belt law, only 4.6% of the occupants in passenger cars, trucks, and buses were **reported** as being belted, that number increased to 73.6% in 1988.

One word of caution, this is **reported** belt use, not observed. Certainly some of the current use rate is attributable to persons falsely indicating they were belted in order to avoid prosecution for failing to wear a seat belt. Peace Officer's reporting of belt use has also improved.

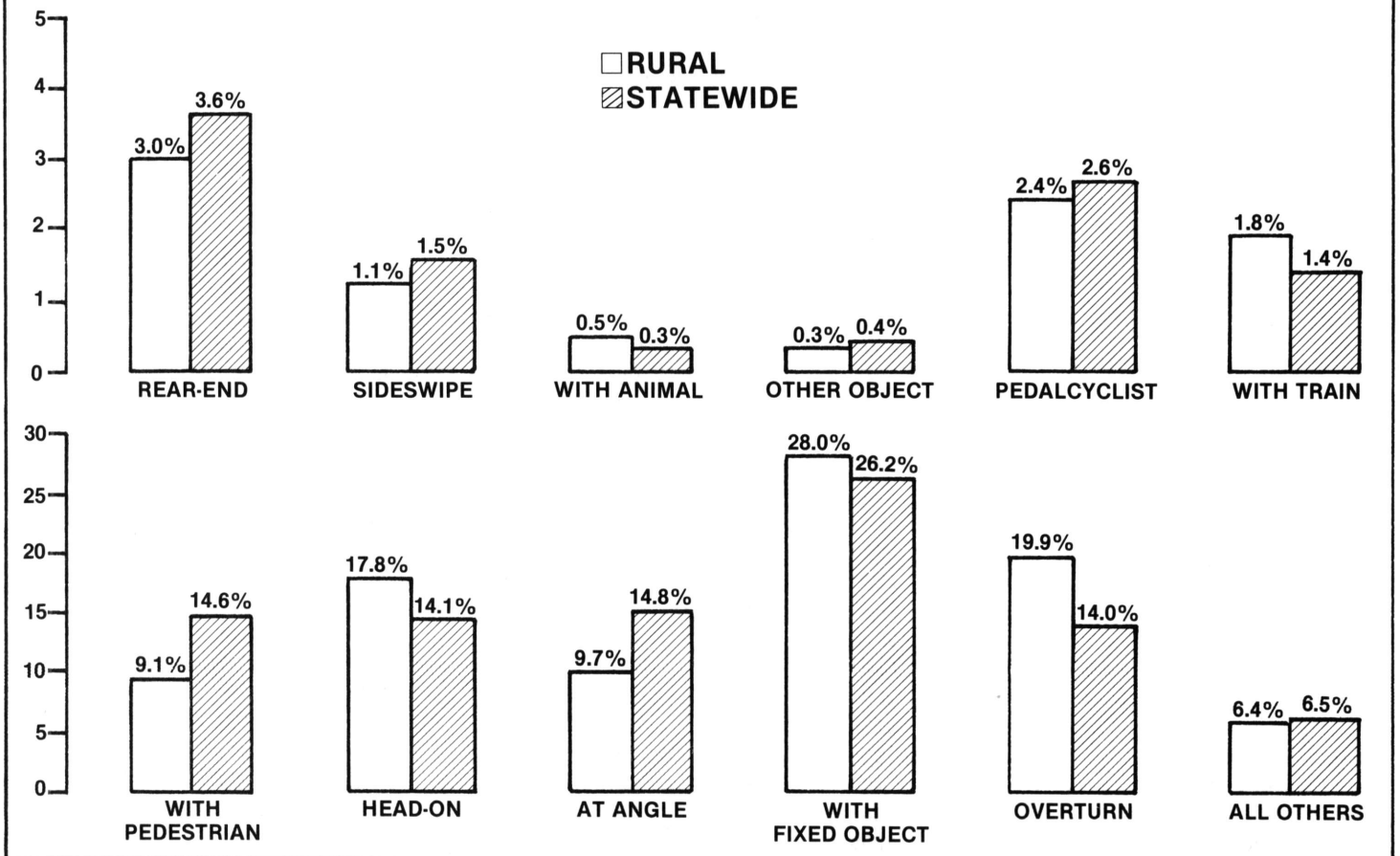

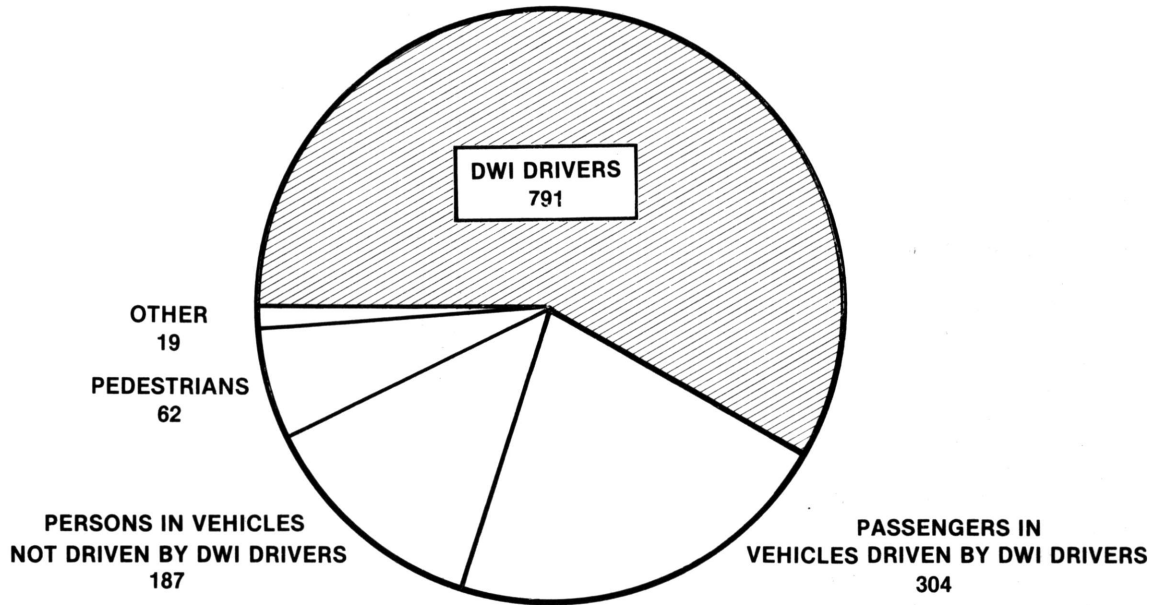

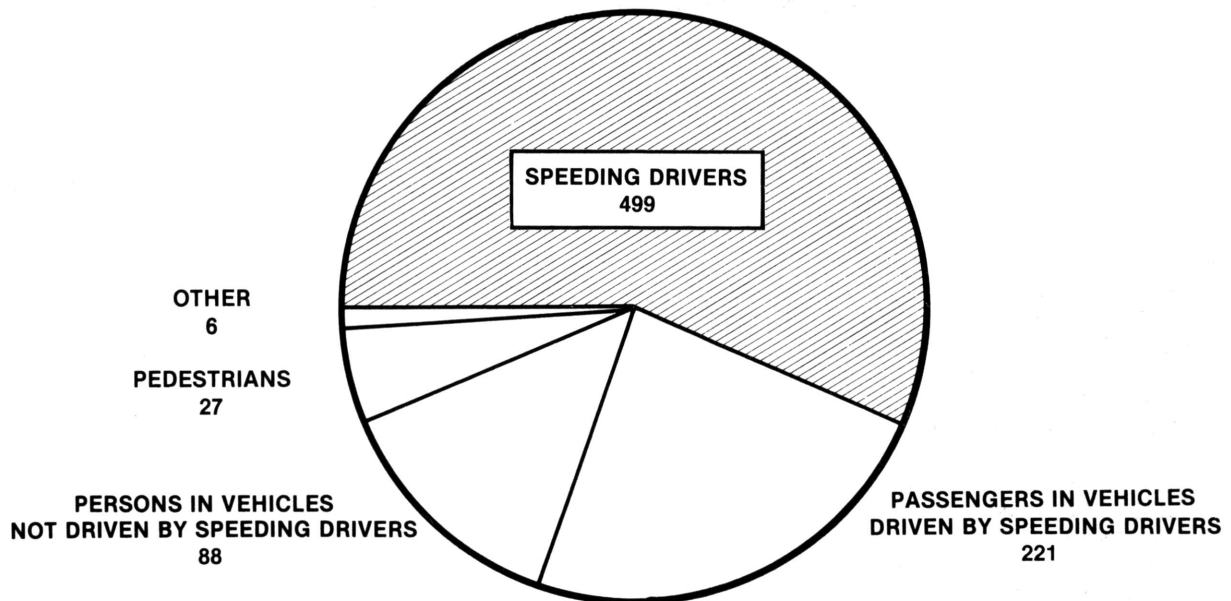
FATAL RURAL AND STATEWIDE MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS THE MANNER OF COLLISION

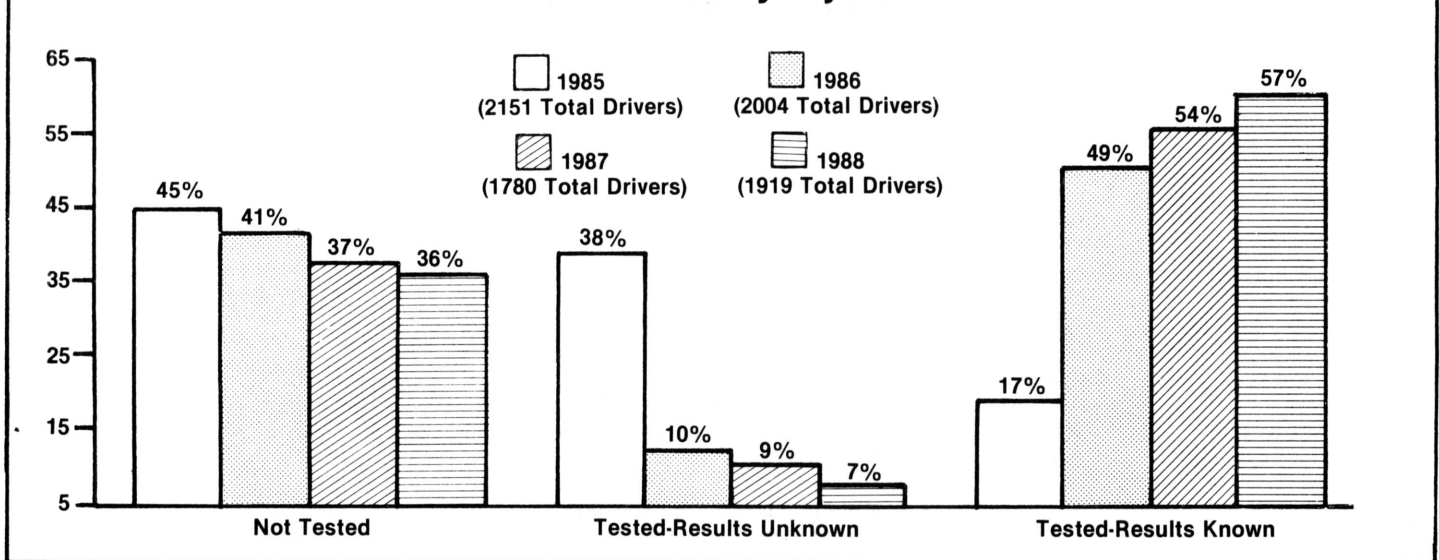

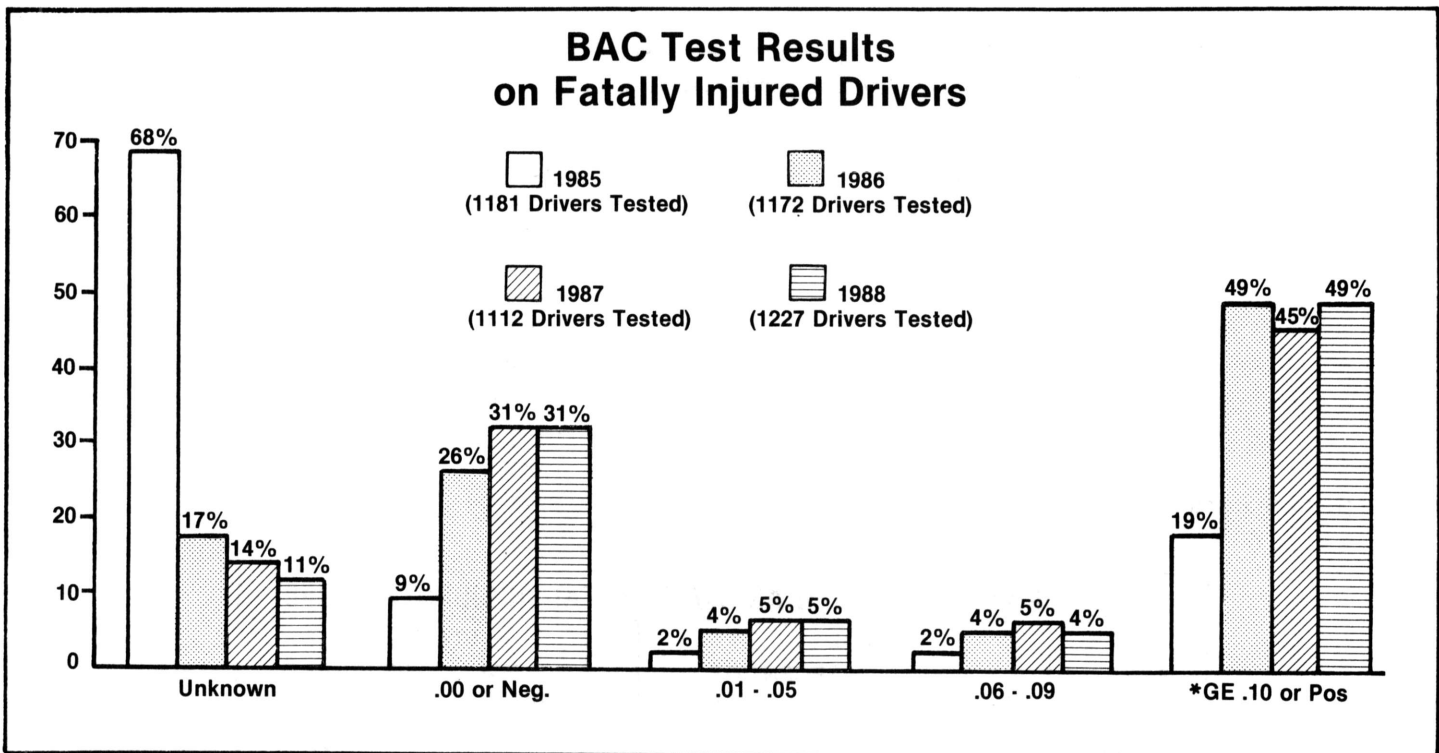
