DEFINITIONS

Motor Vehicle - Every vehicle which is selfpropelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon rails.

Trafficway - The space within property lines or other boundary lines of any way open to the public as a matter of right or custom for moving persons or property from one place to another.

Accident - An unintended event or unstabilized situation that produces injury or damage (harmful event) not directly resulting from a cataclysm.

In Transport - Denotes the state or condition of a motor vehicle which is in motion or within the portion of a way ordinarily used for travel by similar vehicles. When applied to motor vehicles, in transport means in motion or on a roadway.

Motor Vehicle Accident - An accident involving a motor vehicle in transport, but not involving aircraft or watercraft.

Motor Vehicle Traffic Accident - Any motor vehicle accident that occurs on a trafficway or that occurs after the motor vehicle runs off roadway but before events are stabilized.

Urban Accident - A motor vehicle accident that occurs at a location within the limits of a city having 5,000 or more population.

Rural Accident - A motor vehicle accident that cannot be classified as an urban accident.

TRAFFIC HIGHLIGHTS OF 1990

- The death rate on Texas highways was the lowest level ever recorded. The death rate was 2.0 deaths per hundred million miles traveled. This is a 5% decrease from the 1989 death rate of 2.1 deaths per hundred million miles traveled.
- Texas experienced a decrease in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities. The 1990 death toll of 3,243 was a 4% decrease from the 3,361 deaths recorded in 1989 and represents the fewest fatalities since 3,230 people lost their lives in 1976.
- Vehicle miles traveled in Texas during 1990 reached a record high of 163.103 billion, an increase of 2% over the 159.679 billion traveled in 1989. The record high number of miles traveled helped produce the low death rate experienced on Texas highways.
- Fatalities in traffic accidents in rural areas of the state accounted for 55% of the state's traffic fatality count. There were 1,777 deaths in rural traffic accidents. This is a 5% decrease from the 1,871 deaths in rural traffic accidents recorded in 1989.
- There were no deathless days on Texas highways during 1990. There was a decrease in the number of days where there were 20 or more traffic deaths recorded. In 1990, there were 5 days where 20 or more traffic deaths were recorded. In 1989, there were 12 days.
- There were no accidents that resulted in 6 or more fatalities in 1990. The last time this occurred was during 1981.
- Sunday, April 29, was the deadliest day in 1990, with 25 fatalities. The largest number of traffic deaths, 300, was recorded in September. This is the eighth year in a row that no month had more than 400 traffic fatalities recorded.
- Based on reported accidents in 1990:
 - 1 person was killed every 2 hours 42 minutes
 - 1 person was injured every 2 minutes
 - 1 reportable accident occurred every 83 seconds
- Of the 254 counties in Texas, 109 recorded an increase in motor vehicle traffic accident deaths during 1990 as compared with 1989.
- Of all the persons killed in passenger cars, trucks, and buses during 1990, 73.4% were not wearing seat belts when the fatal accident occurred. Statistics show that the chance of being killed in an accident during 1990 were more than thirteen times as great for persons not wearing seat belts as for those wearing seat belts.
- 262,576 people were injured in motor vehicle traffic accidents in 1990. This is an 8% increase from the 1989 figure of 243,030.
- In 1990, there were 1,402 people killed in alcohol related motor vehicle traffic accidents. This is a 7% increase over the 1989 figure of 1,306.
- There were 197 motorcyclists killed in 1990. Even though by law all motorcyclists were required to wear protective headgear, 21% were reported as not wearing helmets when the fatal accident occurred.


Note: Beginning January 1, 1990 the property damage limits for reportable traffic accidents was increased from \$250 to \$500; therefore, no totals except fatal accidents and fatalities can be compared to years prior to 1990.

Beginning with January 1, 1983, a death, from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident, is not counted if it occurs more than 30 days after the accident date. From 1978-1982, fatalities were counted when an injury resulted in death within 90 days of the motor vehicle traffic accident. Previous to 1978, fatalities resulting from an injury accident were counted anytime prior to the statistical cut-off date for the accident year. It should be noted that accident data indicates that about 99% of all deaths from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle traffic accident occur within 30 days of the accident date.

Prior to 1978, an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person, or TOTAL DAMAGE to the apparent extent of \$25.00 or more had to be reported. Accidents occurring on or after January 1, 1978 resulting in injury to or death of any person, or damage to the property of ANY ONE PERSON to the apparent extent of \$250.00 or more had to be reported. Because of this change in reporting laws, the total number of accidents and the number of non-injury property damage accidents cannot be compared with years prior to 1978.



Reported seat belt usage in accidents has been steadily increasing since the implementation of the seat belt law. In 1984, one year prior to the seat belt law, only 4.6% of the occupants in passenger cars, trucks, and buses were **reported** as being belted, that number increased to 74.8% in 1990.

One word of caution, this is **reported** belt use, not observed. Certainly some of the current use rate is attributable to persons falsely indicating they were belted in order to avoid prosecution for failing to wear a seat belt. Peace Officer's reporting of belt use has also improved.







